


# Prophet Yunus & The Fish

Prophet Yunus ﷺ warned the people of Nineveh that Allah would punish them if they kept practicing shirk.

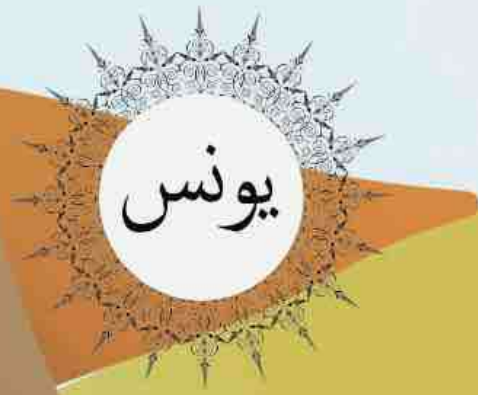
His warning was being ignored and this made him disheartened.
