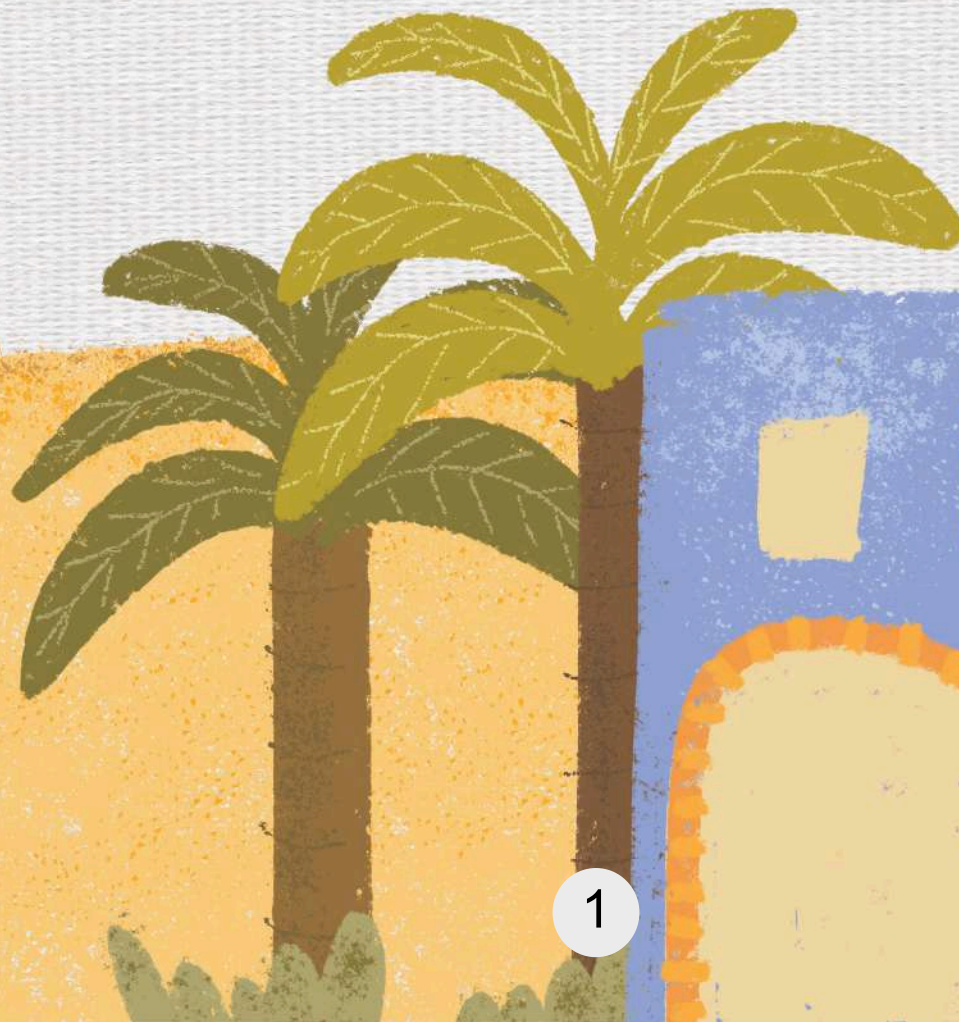


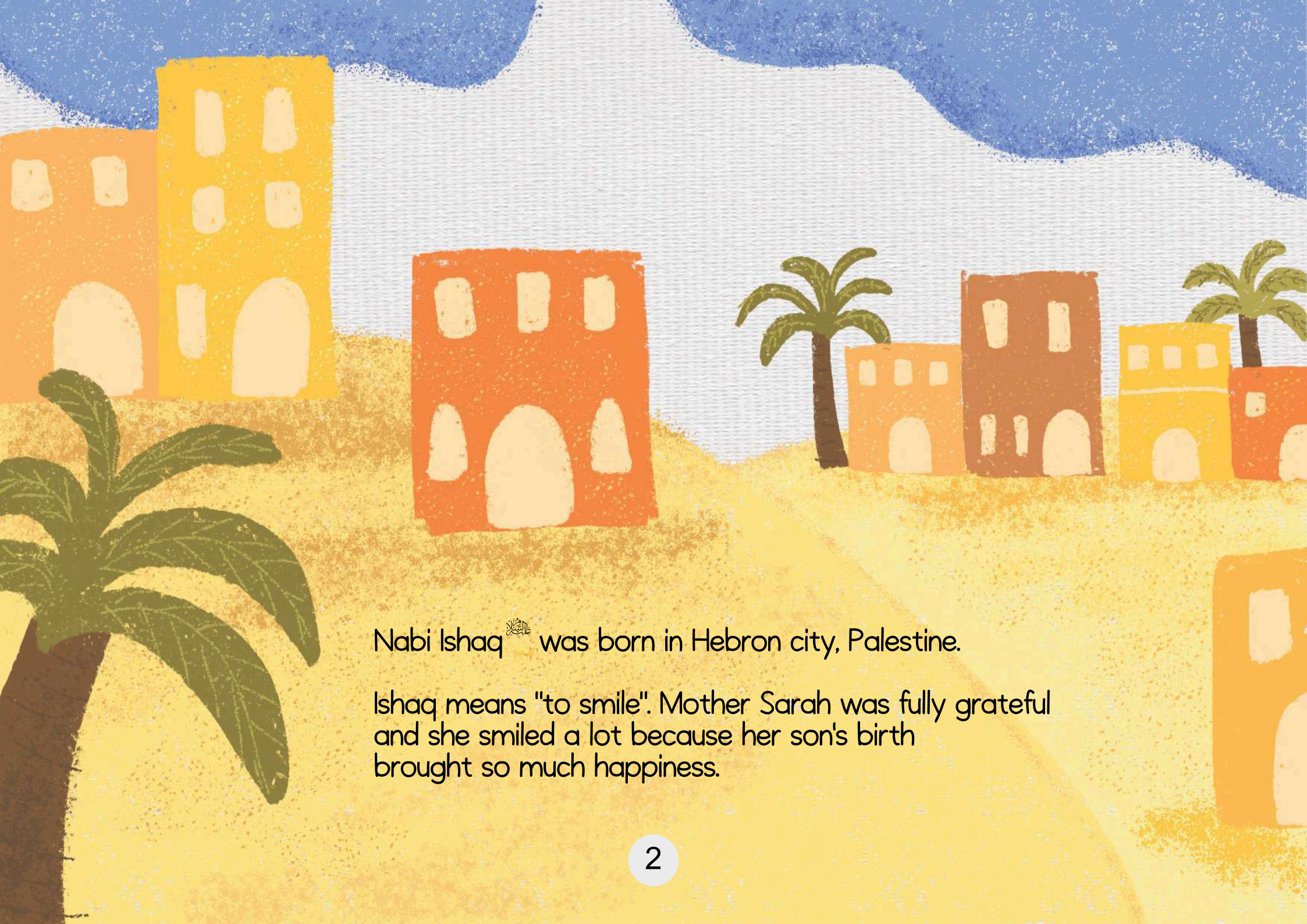
The Story of Nabi Ishaq عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام
